Letter from the President

Dear Alumni Band Supporter,

Over the last few years, we have made significant strides towards being THE organization that FAMU Band alumni and friends are proud to be a part of. We have given close to \$16,000 in scholarships and financial assistance to the FAMU Bands in 2007, up from in excess of \$11,000 the previous year.

- April 2008, we sponsored our first FAMU Band graduates reception in the Foster-Tanner Band Room. Our new graduates received their membership credentials, an alumni band hat, as well as congratulatory speeches from Dr. Julian E. White and me. Organized by recent grads Reson Konchellah and Lynn Dorvil, we have plans to continue this event in hopes that our students will know that we are proud of their accomplishment!
- July 2008 - Reson and Lynn also donated a t-shirt quilt for a fundraising raffle. LaWanda Harper was a recipient of the raffle, and we raised a few more dollars for our students!
- September 2008, the Internal Revenue Service approved our application for non-profit status. That has been a work in progress, but we persevered, and were rewarded with that status for our hard work and dedication to getting the job done.
- We gave a reception and conferred a scholarship in the name of Mrs. Gloria C. Jones in her retirement. She served the FAMU Bands, its students, and alumni well during her tenure as Dr. William P. Foster's secretary, then Dr. Julian E. White's secretary before retiring. She was a great person to know if you were a student/alumnus, and helped us out wherever she could. The scholarship has gone to a student who represents what she stood for while in the department, a hard-working person who went above and beyond the call of duty, and without the fanfare that some of us need and/or desire. Mrs. Jones is enjoying her retirement, and we are enjoying giving a deserving student a \$500 scholarship in her name!
- The Association sponsored an inauguration trip to see the swearing in of our 44th President, Barack Obama. The trip was a long one, but very successful! We were able to see in person what others could only see on TV, and while it was probably nicer for those who sat at home to watch it on TV, freezing for 12 hours while waiting for the "100" to pass by was well worth the trip and effort! Thanks goes to Cicely Mason and her team for putting things together. We have 4 years to plan the next one. ☺
- We are in the process of conferring and approving two chapters. The Tallahassee Chapter (under the leadership of Robert Griffin) and the Atlanta Chapter (under the leadership of Larry Johnson) are working towards taking our national efforts to the local level. We will have more information on the chapters and how you can request one later on in the report.
- We recently started a new fundraising campaign called "10 on the 10th." This is an effort to help us raise moneys for scholarships and book vouchers for our students. You can go online and make your donation, or send it to our PO Box in Tallahassee, FL. Thanks in advance for your donation!

- We have completed the arduous task of web-enabling our database. Daria Bullock, our database administrator, spent many hours working on this project, and you can see the fruits of her labor on the website now. Instead of seeing your financial status take weeks to update on the website, it could be a matter of days before it shows up on the site, maybe even sooner. Our next step would be to have login access to our financial members (regular and associate), so that they can make purchases online. Members can do that currently, but we don't have the security in place the way Daria and I have envisioned it. Daria has built layers of security on the site, so that members will have to log in to make a purchase of merchandise, tickets and other items. CDs and DVDs will still be available for purchase on the main pages of the website, but we want to make sure that our members are the only ones able to reap the benefits of membership within the Association.

With the addition of Cicely Mason (Parliamentarian) and Andre' Cunningham (First Vice-President) we have been moving forward with a sense of urgency and entitlement. Our revitalization is what has the potential to propel us beyond our wildest dreams. Many, many thanks go to Past 1st VP Spencer "Bubba" Bruce. Bubba spent a number of years guiding us in our processes and procedures, and has been a great resource to the Board of Directors!

Corporate structures, policies, and procedures are updated regularly to our operations manuals as we work towards increasing our level of dedication and professionalism, while we make a conscious effort to not let the Association's work have an adverse effect on our personal and professional lives. We like to have work/life balance within the Association, as well.

We are here as long as you need us. We need YOU to continue your support of not only the Association, but of the past, present, and future members of the FAMU Bands!

Communications

Starting January 1, 2009, we merged the responsibilities of the Communications committee with the Financial Secretary, Recording Secretary, and Membership Committee. While our past committee chair, Daria Bullock, is still on the Board as our database administrator, we have maintained our focus in terms of serving our customers, both internal and external.

Education

We sponsored a graduates reception last spring, and have plans to not only continue that event in April, but to incorporate a reception for those graduating in the fall, as well.

We have increased not only the number of scholarships awarded, but the amounts, as well. Book vouchers started at \$100, and were increased to \$200, while the William P. Foster Scholarship went from \$500 to \$1,500.00. This is due to the increased costs of books, as well as our ability to generate (through donations) monies to help our students even more.

In 2007, we awarded ALL of our section leaders, elected officers and drum majors book vouchers in recognition of their hard work put in during pre-drill. With the economy on the downturn, we were not able to do so in 2008, but will look at ways to generate the \$6,000.00 needed to fund the nearly 30 members. One of the ways we can accomplish that is when you give to the “10 on the 10th” campaign!

Our Mentorship Program is going to be the crown jewel of our programs, allowing the Association to assist our students from a fiscal, moral, and supportive standpoint. Through the efforts of our members, we hope to be able to provide the students with various resources that will help them secure internships, as well as permanent positions in their chosen field upon graduation. Look for the program to be started back up this year sometime.

Finance

We moved our finances from being on an individual’s computer to being online. By doing so, our Financial Secretary and Treasurer were able work more efficiently, and any reports needed could be generated by simply logging onto the Quickbooks Online site.

Our last financial audit was a positive one that justified our move to being online. Also, because of our non-profit status we saved about \$150 annually. We’ve been able to file our taxes and have audits done without being physically in the presence of the tax preparers and/or auditors.

We are having another audit done soon, and will publish the results of them as they become available.

As of March 25, our total assets are \$11,737.97.

Membership

Our membership numbers have been steadily increasing over the years, and through various contests, promotions, and a grass-roots campaign, we have a goal to bring in 400 financial members into the Association this year! The Clarinets have been our most consistent section in terms of membership. Which section will step it up this year?

Your membership:

- Name recognition on the website
- Monthly reports from the Board of Directors
- Access to purchase football game tickets where all alumni band members and their friends/family can sit together
- Access to book hotels at a reduced rate
- Ability to purchase merchandise online.

We will also be rewarding our 5-year continuous members with polo shirts again at our annual meeting in July, so when we contact you about your size, please let us know and not let your gift sit in our boxes any more than they should be!

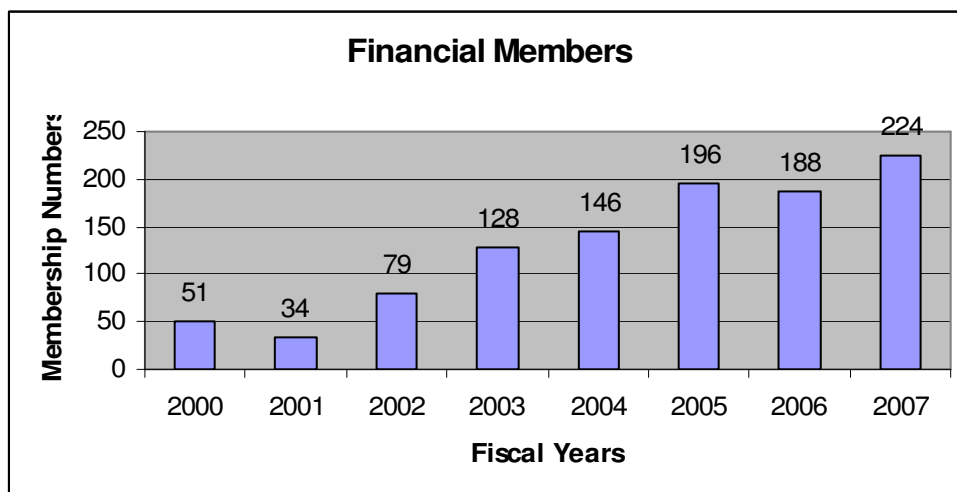
